| Definitions and Terms | <p><i>Individuals with disabilities:</i> They are people with long-term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which, in dealing with various barriers, may prevent them from participating fully and effectively in society on an equal basis with others.</p> <p><i>Individuals with special needs:</i> They are people who need special treatment in both educational and social aspects, in order for them to be able to deal with their peers and colleagues normally.</p> |
| Policy Title | Implementing an appropriate accommodation policy or strategy, including an adequately funded mechanism for individuals with disabilities. |
| Policy Statement | <p>This policy states the significance of applying the laws, instructions, and regulations that ensure the rights of individuals with disabilities at work, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protecting the rights of individuals with disabilities on an equal basis with others, through working towards equal opportunities and equal pay for work, and assigning responsibilities of equal value, safety, and healthy working conditions, including their protection from harassment. • Ensuring the provision of reasonable service facilities for individuals with disabilities in the workplace. • Encouraging individuals with disabilities to acquire professional experiences in the labor market through holding training courses and workshops particularly designed for this purpose. • The university should guarantee that no act of discrimination occurs to individuals with disabilities, as they should be equally protected, similarly to other educators, workers, and employees. • Engaging individuals with disabilities fully and effectively within the university's faculties and centers, both administratively and scientifically. • Looking after adults with disabilities throughout the different stages of higher education, and allocating admissions and grants for those who are interested. |
