#### Means of achieving this goal according to University of Babylon environment:

- Support or organize events aimed to promote conservation and sustainable utilization of the land, including forests and wild land.
- Have policies to ensure that food on campus is sustainably farmed low-income students, non-traditional students, women.
- Work directly to maintain and extend existing ecosystems and their biodiversity, of both plants and animals, especially ecosystems under threat.
- Offer educational programs on ecosystems (looking at wild flora and fauna) for local or national communities.
- Offer educational programe/outreach for local or national communities on sustainable management of land for agriculture and tourism. Free or paid.
- Have a policy to ensure the conservation, restoration and sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems associated with the university, in particular forests, mountains and drylands.
- Have a policy to identify, monitor and protect any IUCN Red Listed species and national
  conservation list species with habits in areas affected by the operation of your university.
- Include local biodiversity into any planning and development process.
- Have a policy to reduce the impact of alien species on Campus.
- Collaborate with the local community to maintain shared land ecosystems.
- Have water quality standards and guidelines for water discharges.
- Have a policy on reducing plastic waste on campus.
- Have a policy, process or practice on waste disposal covering hazardous materials.
