## **SDG16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions**

**Sixteen Goal Means** this goal is dedicated to the promotion of peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, the provision of access to justice for all, and building effective, accountable institutions at all levels. Conflict, insecurity, weak institutions and limited access to justice remain a great threat to sustainable development. The number of people fleeing war, persecution and conflict exceeded 70 million in 2018, the highest level recorded by the UN refugee agency (UNHCR) in almost 70 years. In 2019, the United Nations tracked 357 killings and 30 enforced disappearances of human rights defenders, journalists and trade unionists in 47 countries.

### **Means of achieving this goal according to University of Babylon environment:**

- Having elected representation on the university's highest governing body from.
- Recognition a students' union.
- Having written policies and procedures to identify local stakeholders external to the university and engage with them.
- Having an existence of participatory bodies to recognize and engage local stakeholders, including local residents, local government, local private, local civil society representatives.
- Having a publication of university financial data.
- provide outreach, general education, upskilling and capacity-building to policy- and law-makers on relevant topics e.g. economics, law, technology, climate change
- undertake policy-focused research in collaboration with government departments
- provide a neutral platform and “safe” space for different political stakeholders to come together to frankly discuss challenges?
