- Reviewing the policies of the Ministry concerned with kindergartens and nurseries,
- Reviewing the policies of the Ministry concerned with primary and secondary education,
- Reviewing the policies of the Ministry concerned with vocational and technical education.
- Review the policies of the Ministry of Higher Education.
- Curriculum update annually
- Changing teaching methods and including field visits,
- Follow up the vocabulary of the curricula and activate the supervisory role in the regular periodic
- Providing up-to-date resources
- Update and build libraries,
- Encouraging students to read and study in central and public libraries.
- Training the student to learn rather than teach.
- Presenting scientific studies for the development of schools and vocational preparatory schools and raising proposals to accommodate the rates of population increase,
- Rehabilitation and restoration of schools, institutes and universities.




